Living and Working in Hotels in Scotland for Ukrainians

Introduction

We are providing the opportunity for Ukrainians to come to Scotland and to work in hotels, where you will also live. You will work about 40-45 hours per week and be paid about £9 (10 Euros) per hour. You will have to pay the hotel about £50 per week for your accommodation. You will be asked to stay there at least until 20 September 2022, and many hotels will invite you to continue much longer.

Government Laws about Ukrainians

Scotland is part of the United Kingdom (UK), and the Government in London makes the laws about Ukrainians coming here. On 4th March they announced the “Local Sponsorship Scheme”, which will allow people like me to “sponsor” Ukrainians who come to UK. We are waiting for more information about this. The UK government may ask you to complete an Application Form with information about yourself. I will try to help you with that.

Who can come on this Programme?

I hope to bring 100 Ukrainians. You will need to be aged 18-35. I am sorry but I cannot bring anyone outside this age range, even if they are your children or other relatives. It will be good if you speak English, even if it is only a few words. It will be good too if you have worked previously in a hotel, restaurant or café.

What will happen after 20th September 2022?

Some hotels will want you to stay longer, possibly much longer. Some Ukrainians may want to go to university in UK; or to find work that they are qualified to do. Some may choose to go to some other country. But at 20th September, you will have learnt more English, and saved quite a lot of money. At present the UK “Local Sponsorship Scheme” allows you to stay for 12 months.

At the Hotel where you will work

Your work may be in waitressing in the Restaurant if your English is good enough. There is also work for people who clean the rooms, and help in the kitchen. You may have your own bedroom/bathroom, but may share it with one other person. Many hotels provide a small kitchen for staff to cook their meals, but also provide meals on days when they are working. All hotels will allow you to use a washing machine for your clothes.

I hope that as soon as you arrive in Scotland, several hotel managers will want to meet you at Jobs Fairs, which I shall arrange. Some of these managers will then offer you jobs.

Finally

As you seem much is still uncertain. But I can promise you my determination to make it all happen, and to get you into a Scottish hotel.
